ORDER UNDER SECTION 7

BY virtue of the powers vested in me under Section 7 (1) of the Finance Statute No. 07 of 1990 of the Southern Province, Provincial Council, I, Gustinawadu Shan Wijayalal De Silva, Chief Minister and Minister of Finance of the Southern Province Provincial Council, do by this order, fix the following rates of Turnover Tax shall come into effect from the midnight of 31st October, 2006/01st November, 2006.

The rate of Turnover Tax of 01 percent imposed by Part I of the order published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 644/29 of 12th January, 1991 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka shall cease to apply, upon the coming into effect of this order, in respect of any turnover arising after the midnight of 31st October, 2006/01st November, 2006 in respect of only the turnover of the business referred to in Paragraphs (a) and (b) of this order.
